



Get summer road trip ready

Create a generalized itinerary. Use mapping apps to research the trip before departure and plot out points of interest and where you will rest, fuel up (both body and vehicle) and stay overnight.

Slow is pro. A large part of the road trip is about the ride itself. Resist the temptation to speed and rush through various towns. Get out and stretch your legs as much as possible and take advantage of roadside attractions, tourist traps, rest stops, restaurants, and so much more.

· Find your inspiration to travel. Check out travel blogs, online videos and magazines or get recommendations from friends and family regarding spots of interest. Maybe you've always dreamed about seeing the California Redwoods but you live on the East Coast? It may take several days, but an epic road trip adventure can get you to your destination no matter how far away it might be.

Emphasize fuel efficiency. Fuel is one of the biggest expenses on a road trip. Before setting out on the trip, ensure that the vehicle is inspected and road-ready. This means that oil and fluids have been changed and the tires are in good shape (with a spare on hand). While driving, stick to the speed limit and do not overpack the vehicle, as more weight leads to greater fuel consump-

How to handle fireworks safely

Warm weather generally translates to more time spent outdoors. That means more barbecues, days spent poolside, trips to the beach. and even camping excursions. This time of year also inspires people to celebrate. What better way to signal the party has started than with fireworks?

Firework traditionally are part of large celebrations, such as national holidays or grand opening events. Many individuals also take it on themselves to set off firework during block parties or other neighborhood gatherings. Though fireworks are awe-inspiring, they're also dangerous, which is why it's best to leave them to the professionals.

The US. Consumer Product Safety Commission reports that fireworks-related injuries and deaths in the United States have risen by roughly 25 percent in the last 5 years. In 20 people died in accidents involving fireworks, and 1,1 **6**w ere injured.

"The safest way to enjoy fireworks is to watch the professional displays," said Alex Hoeh-Saric, chair of the CPSC.

Three-quarters of firework injuries occur the week before and following the July 4th holiday in the United States. The Canadian



Government indicates twothirds of all fireworks-related injuries in Canada occur between May and August, with nearly one-third happening on days surrounding Victoria Day and Canada

Firework can injure any part of the body, but burns to the hands and fingers, trunk, and arms are the most commonly affected areas. Injuries to the eyes, including blindness, also may occur.

Spark ers are not necessarily safe, either. The CPSC reports that ,10 juries result from spark ers each year.

As fireworks become widely available, it's imperative that individuals follow these crucial safety tips when using them.

- · Never allow children to play with or ignite any type of firework, including spar-
- Keep a buck t of water or garden hose nearby to extinguish fires or sparks.
- · Only buy and use fire-

work if they are legal.

- Light fireworks one at a time in accordance with manufacturers' instructions.
- Choose a field or area free from trees and other obstructions, far away from spectators to light fireworks.
- Never use fireworks while impaired by alcohol
- Never point or fire firework in the direction of other people.
- Do not place any part of the body directly over firework when lighting a fuse.

Firework can be beautiful, but are best left to the professionals.



9 facts about the Declaration of Independence

The Declaration of Independence is a document that indicates the founding principles of the United States of America. The declaration was issued by the Continental Congress on July 4, 1776, and announced the separation of the 13 British colonies in North America from the United Kingdom.

That significance means the public may want to learn more about the Declaration of Independence. Here are some key facts.

1. While Thomas Jefferson wrote the Declaration of Independence, it was carefully reviewed and modified by other members of the Continental Congress, notably John Adams and Benjamin Franklin.

2. The Continental Congress actually voted for independence on July 2, 1776. The written Declaration was dated July 4, 1776, but it wasn't actually signed until August 2nd of that year. John Adams thought July 2nd would be marked as the national holiday.

3. Fifty-six delegates



signed the Declaration of Independence, but not all were present on that day in August.

4. While many know that John Hancock signed first, with his prominent signature readily visible, it is believed that Thomas McKean of Delaware was the last person to sign.

5. Others signed according to state delegation and

in columns, starting with the northernmost state (New Hampshire) to the southernmost (Georgia).

6. About 200 copies of the Dunlap Broadside were printed. Today, 26 copies remain.

7. The original rough draft of the Declaration of Independence has been lost.

8. The Declaration of dated 4th July 1776.

Independence was not universally accepted, and many people in the colonies remained loyal to the British monarchy and opposed American independence.

9. The Declaration of Independence has a message written on the back of it. It reads, "Original Declaration of Independence dated 4th July 1776"

Tips to save when shopping for your July Fourth barbecue

The HPBA notes that chick en thighs, legs or ga rters also tend to be less expensive than chick n breasts.

Vegetables are less expensive than meat and poultry, and there's many ways to prepare veggies over an open flame. Grilled vegetable skewers are flavorful and popular, and guests might appreciate some nutritious fare to counter all the less healthy items they're accustomed to eating at July 4 barbecues.

Prepare pets for Fourth of July festivities

Check with the vet


