

## Remedies for creaky floors

coveted features in many homes. The National Wood Flooring Association says wood floors are the most environmentally friendly flooring options available. In the United States, the hardwood forests that provide flooring products are



Hardwood floors are growing twice as fast as they are being harvested. Furthermore, wood floors can last for many generations and require fewer raw materials to produce than other flooring options. That means less waste may end up in landfills.

Hardwood floors can endure for decades in a home, but over time those same floors may need some tender loving care to keep them looking good and working as they should. Squeaky floors are a common nuisance that homeowners may experience. Squeaking is often caused by movement and fric-

tion between floorboards. Treating the problem involves identifying the underlying issue.

#### Loose hardware

Squeaky floors may be due to the loosening of the hardware holding the floor in place, says The Home Depot. When nails or screws no longer are secured tightly, the boards can rub together. The noise heard is the sound produced by rubbing. Tightening or replacing the hardware can help reduce the squeaking.

#### Counter-snap kit meth-

This Old House says this kit method is a great way to fix squeaks without damaging the floor. Once the source of the squeak is located, drill a 3/32inch pilot hole through the hardwood flooring. Then inser t a screw through the



kit's depth-control fixture and into the pilot hole, and drive it until it automatically snaps off below the wood surface. Follow this up by filling the hole with wood putty that matches the floor color. Once the putty is dry, lightly sand the area to blend.

#### Use a shim or shims

Sometimes the floor may squeak because of a gap between the joists and the subfloor. Filling the gap with a small piece of wood called a shim can help alleviate the gap or gaps.

#### Drive up screws

If a squeak is just in one

spot, The Home Depot says that you may be able to drive short screws from below into the subfloor.

#### Small gaps

For small gaps between boards, sprinkle talcum powder or powdered graphite between squeaky boards to reduce friction. Wood filler applied with a putty knife also may work. For larger gaps, use a liquid filler designed for wood floors.

Homeowners also can visit their local home improvement center for other hardware solutions designed for underfloor repairs to remedy squeaks. Many work from underneath the floor and involve mounting plates or brackets to sure up the floor.

Squeaky floors can be problematic, but noises can be banished with some repair work.

## Tips for winterizing exterior living areas

• Pools and spas: It's essential to follow the industry or manufacturer recommendations for closing down swimming pools and spas for the season. While covers may not be essential

in all climates, covering can help prevent leaves and other debris from getting in the water. Water should be expelled from pipes and tubing to prevent freezing and bursting. If space allows, consider moving the pool pump indoors to prolong its longevity. Turn off the electricity to the outlet where the filter is plugged

There may be additional, region-specific steps to winterize a property, but these pointers are a good starting point to protect outdoor spaces.

## Signs it's time to replace gutters

Home improvement projects run the gamut from complex undertakings like room additions to simpler renovations like a new front door. Some home renovations excite homeowners more than others, but all improvements are a way to make a home safer, more comfortable and/or more functional.

• Rust: Rust is rarely a good sign whether you're looking at a vehicle or even garden tools. Rust also is a


bad sign in relation to gutters. Gutters are painted, and not only for aesthetic purposes. Paint on gutter also serves to protect them from water. When paint begins to flake, gutters will begin to rust and may even produce noticeable rust flakes on the ground below. Rust on gutters and rust flakes beneath them are indicative of gutters that need to be replaced.

• Gutters pulling away from the home: Gutters that appear to be pulling away from the home is a sign that they need to be replaced. Gutters are fastened to a home during installation, which ensures they can withstand rain and water. Over time, those fasteners can wear down, ultimately leading to gutters that appear to be pulling away from the home. Though gutters can be refastened, eventually they will need to be replaced.

• Pooling water: Pooling water in a gutter may just be a sign that gutters need to be cleaned. However, pooling water on the ground directly beneath gutters indicates they're not effectively directing water away from the home.

• Water damage inside: A home's interior might not be the first place homeowners look when inspecting for damaged gutters, but a flooded basement or crawl space could indicate a gutter problem. Gutters and downspouts are designed to direct water away from a home when functioning properly. When that isn't happening, water can pool beneath the foundation, leading to pooling water and other water damage in basements and crawl spaces.

Gutter replacement projects may not be exciting, but new gutters can make a home safer and prolong the life of a roof and other features on a property.





## A guide to fall lawn care for cool-season grasses

Spring is the season most often associated with lawn care, and for good reason. Grass starts growing in spring, and the season is a great time to fertilize many grasses in the hopes lawns can look their best and endure the hotter, dryer weather of summer.

Spring might mark the time when many homeowners begin tending to their lawns each year, but it's important to recognize the significance of fall lawn care as well. Cool-season grasses like perennial ryegrass and Kentucky bluegrass are common in various regions, and the following strategies can help homeowners with these types of grasses tend to their lawns this fall.

• Stick to your recommended fertilization schedule. Homeowners who have been fertilizing since spring are urged to continue doing so in fall at the recommended interval. It's easy to forget to fertilize in fall thanks that don't call lawn care to mind and busier schedules after school starts again and summer vacation season ends. But many fertilizer manufacturers advise users of their products to fertilize several times over the course of the year, including in fall. Stick to the intervals recommended on the packaging of the fertilizer you've been using, making sure not to forget to fertilize this fall.

- Conduct a soil test. A soil test can determine if the soil is lacking any nutritive elements it needs to come back strong in spring. Certain amendments can restore pH balance if necessary and foster stronger growth when lawns come back in spring.
- Aerate, if necessary. Soil can become compacted over time, and that can cause a range of problems for a lawn. Compacted soil can make it harder for water to reach the roots of grass, which weakens grass and makes it more vulnerable to damage during adverse weather events like drought. Compacted soil also makes it harder for nutrients in fertilizer to get into the soil. Aerating is best left to professionto cooler temperatures als, particularly in larger

## Tips to winterize your vehicle

The elements pose a unique challenge to motor vehicles, and that's particularly notable when seasons change. Though the shift from spring to summer or even summer to fall may not be too significant, drivers who want to safeguard their vehicles would be wise to take certain measures to prepare their cars or trucks for winter weather.

Winterizing a car can be an important part of vehicle maintenance. That's particularly true for vehicle owners who live in regions where winter is marked by especially cold temperatures and/or significant snowfall. As fall gives way to winter, drivers can take these steps to winterize their vehicles.

 Address tires and tire pressure. The experts at Kelley Blue Book note the danger of aging and/ or poorly inflated tires, particularly in winter. Icy, wet and/or snow-covered roads can be dangerous to traverse, so it benefits drivers to examine their tires prior to winter. Worn down treads reduce traction and make it more difficult for vehicles to stop, which is already challenging on roads where ice is present. It's equally important to keep tires properly inflated, as KBB reports each 10-degree dip in temperature can lead to a onepound loss in air pressure. Poorly inflated tires can decrease performance and safety on the road.

• Check the battery and replace it, if necessary. Another step to winterize a car involves the battery that helps to keep the vehicle running. The auto-



motive experts at Firestone note that sinking temperatures force the chemical reaction within vehicle batteries to slow, which reduces the amount of power the battery can generate. In fact, Firestone estimates a battery can lose as much as 60 percent of its strength in freezing temperatures. Firestone urges drivers to get a battery assessment test prior to winter to ensure the battery is healthy enough to endure the coming months. If the assessment indicates the battery

is weak, replace it prior to winter.

· Check fluid levels. Routine vehicle maintenance at an auto body shop or car dealership typically involves checking and topping off fluid levels. Book such an appointment in advance of winter to ensure the vehicle has coolant, which KBB notes is formulated to resist freezing. Without sufficient coolant, a vehicle engine can suffer significant damage. Windshield washer fluid also should be filled

to ensure the windshield can be sufficiently cleaned of salt during and after snowstorms. A pre-winter oil change also can help the vehicle run smoothly throughout the colder months.

• Inspect belts and hoses.

KBB notes cold weather weakens belts and hoses, which can become brittle and fail in low temperatures. Belts and hoses should be checked prior to winter. Engines can overheat, electrical system problems can emerge and

power steering may be compromised if belts and hoses are allowed to fall into disrepair.

Winter can be a challenging time of year for cars

and trucks. Various strategies to winterize a car before the mercury drops can make it safer to be on the road when the weather turns cold.

## How parents can raise healthy eaters

Parents face no shortage of challenges when raising their children. Some challenges are overcome easier than others, but one that tends to have more staying power than most is the difficulty some parents experience as they try to get their children to eat healthy diets.

A 2024 poll from C.S. Mott Children's Hospital found that 27 percent of parents of children between the ages of three and 10 indicate their youngsters don't like healthy food and more than half indicate their kids are picky eaters. Such responses underscore the challenges parents face as they attempt

to raise healthy eaters. Despite those challenges, many parents have met with considerable success in their efforts to raise healthy eaters, and various strategies can facilitate those efforts.

• Recognize that being picky at the dinner table is normal. It's undeniably frustrating for parents when kids are picky about their food, but childcare experts note such behavior is normal. The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia note that children across the globe go through a phase marked by picky eating between the ages of two and four. So parents can make a concerted effort to remain patient if kids suddenly become picky about what they eat. Most grow out of the phase soon enough.

• Remain patient when presenting healthy foods. Just as patience is paramount when navigating the picky eating phase, it's important to remain so when introducing new foods like vegetables and other healthy fare. The CHOP notes that studies have found kids may not accept new foods until it's been offered as much as 15 times, so parents must remain patient if the nutritious foods they're offering are new to kids' diets.

• Invite kids to choose and prepare meals. Giving kids some agency over

what they eat and asking them to pitch in during meal prep can make them more excited about mealtime regardless of what's on their plate. UCLA Health notes there are a range of kid-friendly meal preparation tasks. Kids can wash fruits and vegetables in the sink, tear leafy greens and even measure ingredients as they get older.

• Visit a local farm.

Some kids may be more excited to eat healthier foods like fruits and vegetables after visiting a local farm and seeing where the foods are grown. Parents can start by visiting farms that grow healthy foods that kids are more likely to eat, such as strawberries and blueberries. A day spent picking apples in the fall also might encourage youngsters to eat more fruit.

· Limit dinner table distractions. Distractions at the dinner table, like smartphones, tablets and toys that were not cleared away before sitting down to eat, can prolong mealtime, which can make kids less enthusiastic about eating. In a report from the CHOP, Dr. Katherine Dahlsgaard of the hospital's Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences noted that kids get the majority of their calories in the first 20 minutes of a meal. Setting a happy, distraction-free tone at the start of a meal can get kids eating and reduce the chances they lose interest in what's on their plate.

A nutritious diet benefits kids in the short- and long-term. Though it's not always easy to get kids to eat healthy, parents can employ various strategies to accomplish that goal.
